

## Iron and Steel Products Originating from Russia Policy Statement

1<sup>st</sup> October 2023

## **Definition:**

According to Article 3g(1)(d) of Regulation (EU) No. 833/2014, as of September 30, 2023, it is prohibited to import or purchase products listed in Annex XVII, which were manufactured in a third country using iron and steel products originating from Russia, into the EU.

## Our policy:

- We purchase material from EU steel mills
- We do not directly import material into the EU from other countries
- We do not directly import material to the UK from the EU or other countries

The material we source has been manufactured in the EU. We use trusted, reputable sources for supply of raw material, and have gained confirmation from these sources that, to the best of their knowledge, no material or components of that material have been sourced from Russia.

There is minimal risk however that small trace amounts of material originating from Russia may still be present. This is due to a high percentage of all steel made in the EU being made from recycled scrap material.
